Attached you will find our application for a Ni 63 sealed source unit we use in a gas chromatograph detector. This is submitted in connection with our License 29-19389-01 which, through an oversight, expired on May 31, 1985.

We have licenses for many items and it is usual practice with the others that we are informed about pending renewal dates. The NRC does not send out renewal notices and with a 5-year life, the date just got away from us.

To avoid this occurrence, we have set up a time reminder file for this particular license so that a renewal application can be sent far in advance of the expiration date.

We regret the oversight and any confusion it has created.

The isotope is in a sealed capsule inside the chromatograph detector block where it will remain.

Our check for fee under category 3P of \$230 is enclosed.

Your prompt reissuance of this license would be appreciated.
