NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Preston Memorial Hospital

The following violations were identified during an inspection conducted on March 24, 1986. The Severity Levels were assigned in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C).

License Condition 16 requires that except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use licensed material described in Items 6, 7, and 8 of this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in your application with ALARA Program and other enclosures dated February 23, 1981; and letter dated March 3, 1982. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern the licensee's statements in applications or letters, unless the statements are more restrictive than the regulations.

 Item 10 of the application requires that the dose calibrator be tested for linearity guarterly.

Contrary to the above, the dose calibrator was not tested for linearity between January 11, 1983 and August 4, 1983; between November 30, 1983 and May 2, 1984; and between August 16, 1984 and May 1, 1985.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

 Item 7 of the application requires that the Medical Isotopes Committee meet quarterly.

Contrary to the above, the Committee did not meet between September 1983 and May 1, 1984; and between September 1984 and January 1985.

This is a Severity Level V violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within 30 days of the date of this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) admission or denial of the alleged violations; (2) the reasons for the violations if admitted; (3) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (4) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (5) the date when full compliance will be achieved.

Security or safeguards information should be submitted as an enclosure to facilitate withholding it from public disclosure as required by 10 CFR 2.790(d) or 10 CFR 73.21.
