Under the Uranium Mill Tailings Radiation Control Act of 1978 (Public Law 95-604), the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is authorized to conduct remedial action at properties contaminated with residual radioactive material from designated inactive uranium mill sites.

Evaluation of your property identified above has not revealed the precence of residual radioactive material from one of these sites in excess of standards established by the Environmental Protection Agency. Therefore, the DOE has determined your property does not require remedial action under the Uranium Mill Tailings Remedial Action Project. For your records, we have enclosed two copies of the survey report on your property.
