SUBJECT: CONSIDERATION OF EARTHQUAKES IN EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLANNING

THE NRC IS PRESENTLY CONSIDERING AMENDING ITS REGULATIONS IN 10 CFR, PART 50, TO FORMALIZE VARIOUS COMMISSION INTERIM RULINGS WHICH STATED THAT NO CONSIDERATION NEED BE GIVEN TO THE POTENTIAL IMPACT OF EARTHQUAKES ON NUCLEAR EMERGENCY PLANNING FOR NUCLEAR REACTOR SITES. (NOT TO BE CONFUSED WITH THE REQUIRED CONSIDERATION OF EARTHQUAKES IN THE DESIGN OF NUCLEAR POWER PLANTS.)

BEFORE TAKING ACTION ON THE ABOVE AMENDMENT, THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS (ACRS) WOULD LIKE TO FIND OUT WHAT APPROACHES MAY HAVE BEEN TAKEN IN YOUR RESPECTIVE COUNTRIES REGARDING THE ABOVE SUBJECT MATTER, AND ANY UNDERLYING STUDIES THAT WERE USED TO ARRIVE AT THE CURRENT POSITIONS.

YOUR ASSISTANCE IN OBTAINING THIS INFORMATION ON OR BEFORE APRIL 19 WOULD BE GREATLY APPRECIATED AND WILL BE CONSIDERED BY THE ACRS IN MAKING ITS RECOMMENDATION ^{TO THE COMMISSION.}

(NOT TO BE CONFUSED WITH THE REQUIRED CONSIDERATION OF EARTHQUAKES IN THE DESIGN OF NUCLEAR POWER PLANTS.)

BEFORE TAKING ACTION ON THE ABOVE AMENDMENT, THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS (ACRS) WOULD LIKE TO FIND OUT WHAT APPROACHES MAY HAVE BEEN TAKEN IN YOUR RESPECTIVE COUNTRIES REGARDING THE ABOVE SUBJECT MATTER, AND ANY UNDERLYING STUDIES THAT WERE USED TO ARRIVE AT THE CURRENT POSITIONS.

YOUR ASSISTANCE IN OBTAINING THIS INFORMATION ON OR BEFORE APRIL 19 WOULD BE GREATLY APPRECIATED AND WILL BE CONSIDERED BY THE ACRS IN MAKING ITS RECOMMENDATION [^] TO THE COMMISSION.
