The examination is scheduled in accordance with the commitment described in the November 27, 1985 referenced letter. Philadelphia Electric Company proposes to submit, within 90 days of returning Unit 3 to service, the plans for the midcycle examinations for NRC review and concurrence. The proposed submittal will be based on the suggestions provided by the NRC during a December 19, 1985 meeting in Bethesda, Maryland.
