Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations in 10 CFR Part 51, notice is hereby given that a Draft Environmental Statement (DES) (NUREG-1166) has been prepared by the Commission's Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation related to the proposed decommissioning of the Humboldt Bay Power Plant Unit No. 3 in Humboldt County, California. The DES addresses the aquatic, terrestrial, radiological, social and economic impacts associated with decommissioning.

Copies of the DES are available for inspection by the public in the Commission's Public Document Room at 1717 H Street, N.W. Washington, D. C. 20555, and at the Eureka-Humboldt County Library, 421 I Street (County Courthouse), Eureka, California. Upon written request to the Division of Technical Information and Document Control, Publication Services Section, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington D. C. 20555, and to the extent available, single copies of the DES will be made available to interested persons without charge.

Interested persons may submit comments on this DES for the Commission's consideration. Federal, State, and specified local agencies are being

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
provided with copies of the DES. Other local agencies may obtain these documents upon request.

Comments by Federal, State and local officials, or other members of the public received by the Commission will be made available for public inspection at the Commission's Public Document Room in Washington, D. C. and the Eureka-Humboldt County Library. Comments are due by June 16, 1986. After consideration of the comments submitted on the DES, the Commission's staff will prepare a Final Environmental Statement, the availability of which will be published in the FEDERAL REGISTER.

Comments on the DES from interested members of the public should be addressed to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, D. C. 20555, Attention: Director, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation.
