Dear Mr. Petterson:

This is to inform you that the Atomic Energy Commission has issued Amendment No. 7 to Provisional Operating License No. DPR-7. The license authorizes the Pacific Gas and Electric Company to operate its nuclear reactor located in Humboldt County, California, at steady state power levels up to 165 megawatts (thermal). The amendment authorizes the licensee to conduct a 7-day test program to demonstrate power operation of the Humboldt Bay Unit No. 3 reactor at power levels up to 230 megawatts (thermal), as described in the application for license amendment dated April 13, 1964. This 7-day test program represents the balance of a 15-day test program previously authorized by License Amendment No. 5 issued December 3, 1963. Copies of the amendment and related Federal Register notice are enclosed.

Also enclosed is a copy of Change No. 14 to the Technical Specifications of License No. DPR-7, together with the related AEC hazards analysis. Change No. 14 authorizes the necessary changes in the Technical Specifications to permit the conduct of the test program.
