SUBJECT: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY - AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO INDEMNITY
AGREEMENT NO. B-21 - DOCKET NOS. 50-133, 70-653

On February 13, 1963 Amendment No. 1 to Indemnity Agreement No. B-21 was issued. The amendment changed the amount of financial protection from the \$1,000,000 previously required as a "storage only" situation to \$3,500,000, the required amount for operation to the 10 MWth authorized as Phase I of operation by PG&E under the provisions of the Technical Specifications accompanying License No. DPR-7. Subsequent power increases through Phase V (full power) will require increases in the amount of financial protection. A telegram from NELIA to the Director, Division of Licensing and Regulation dated February 11, 1963 certified that PG&E's Policy No. NF-113 would be increased to the \$3,500,000 level effective February 13, 1963.

In accordance with a request from PG&E dated January 25, 1963, Amendment No. 1 to the indemnity agreement also changed the definition of the "location" by reference to a map furnished by PG&E, wherein minor changes in the position of the fence line were indicated. The map which was dated January 7, 1963 (revised) was reviewed and it was concluded that the proposed change in the definition of the location was not of significance.

The indemnity fee at this power level (0-10 MWth) will be \$300.00 per year, effective February 13, 1963.
