

PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

Inform the Plant Radiation Protection Officer or person responsible for the use of the source as to the situation. 4. Inform the Region III NRC office of the accident by dialing 1-312-790-5625. Notify Kay-Ray at 1-800-323-7594 or 1-312-259-5600 if their assistance is desired. 6. Limit access to source housing until a radiation survey and source wipe can be performed by a qualified person or Kay-Ray representative.
