Wells Eddleman's Supplement re Argonne National Laboratory Evaluators' Info, Opposing Summary Disposition of Contentions EPX-2 and EPX-8

Pursuant to oral order, Tr. 10856-57, Wells Eddleman hereby files a supplement opposing summary disposition of Contentions EPX-2 and -8 including information obtained in a conference call 3-07-86.

Re EPX-2, evaluators Carolyn (Caroline?) Herzenberg and Karen Gaziel observed, respectively, one and several (not certain of the number of times) that radiological survey teams had to relay information to base because of lack of direct communication. Gaziel said "at times, field team (SRAD-1) was unable to communicate, but was able to relay information to base" as info was required. (see last 3 lines also, re EPX-2)

Re EPX-8, Tony Fultman (Foltman?) or Argonne observed a discussion of EBS coordination on Day 2 (May 18) at 0809 hours. This is long after the time of the conference call CP&L claims had the main problems. Since Fultman's job was to observe radiation protection, he says, he did not note details. (Various Argonne evaluators reported hearing an EBS message at 1542 hours, Day 1 (consistent with FFMA report re EPX-5), and 0845, 0906, and 1257 hours on Day 2. I note this apparent inconsistency with Applicants' statements on summary disposition as to when the EBS was activated (see paragraphs 9 and 21 of "Statement of Material Facts ... on EPX-8") unless there was a long delay, 21 min, in EBS broadcasting early on the 18th (Day 2). Argonne evaluator Chris Saricks also observed Harnett county personnel using a pay phone to make a call to their office. These facts add support to my opposition to summary disposition re EPX-2 & 8.
