STANDING ORDER NO. G-13

Subject: Personnel Conduct

Procedure:

- 1.0 The primary function of the District is to serve our customers well and at the lowest rates commensurate with a high standard of service; to conduct our business with courtesy, efficiency, and dispatch; to treat our customers fairly and without discrimination; and to deal frankly and openly with the public at all times.
- 2.0 Safety and safe practices in all work assignments and plant operations is a firm requirement.
- 3.0 All personnel are expected to conduct themselves in a manner commensurate with the high degree of personal and nuclear safety required by nuclear power plants.
- 4.0 All types of frivolous behavior are strictly forbidden and will be dealt with harshly.
- 5.0 Each staff member has a personal obligation to inform his supervisor if his mental or physical health might impair the ability of him to accomplish his job.
- 6.0 Strict adherence to all plant procedures is mandatory.
- 7.0 All personnel must assure themselves that they completely understand the task to be accomplished prior to starting the work.
- 8.0 All personnel should continuously watch for any degradation of plant equipment and procedures and report any such findings to their supervisor immediately.

- _____ (3) The licensee could compromise a future investigation/inspection because of knowledge gained from the release of information, especially if wrongdoing is involved.
- _____ (4) There is a perceived risk that the release of information could bring harm to the allegor.
- _____ (5) The allegation is made against the licenses, management or those parties who would normally receive and address the allegation.
- _____ (6) The licensee, applicant or vendor has displayed an inability to "self investigate" the type of information provided.
- _____ (7) The allegor has voiced persuasive objections over the release of the allegation to the licensee.
- _____ (8) The allegation is based on intelligence from another governmental agency, which does not approve of the information being released in a referral.
- _____ (9) The allegation does not warrant follow-up and/or the allegation is frivolous in nature.

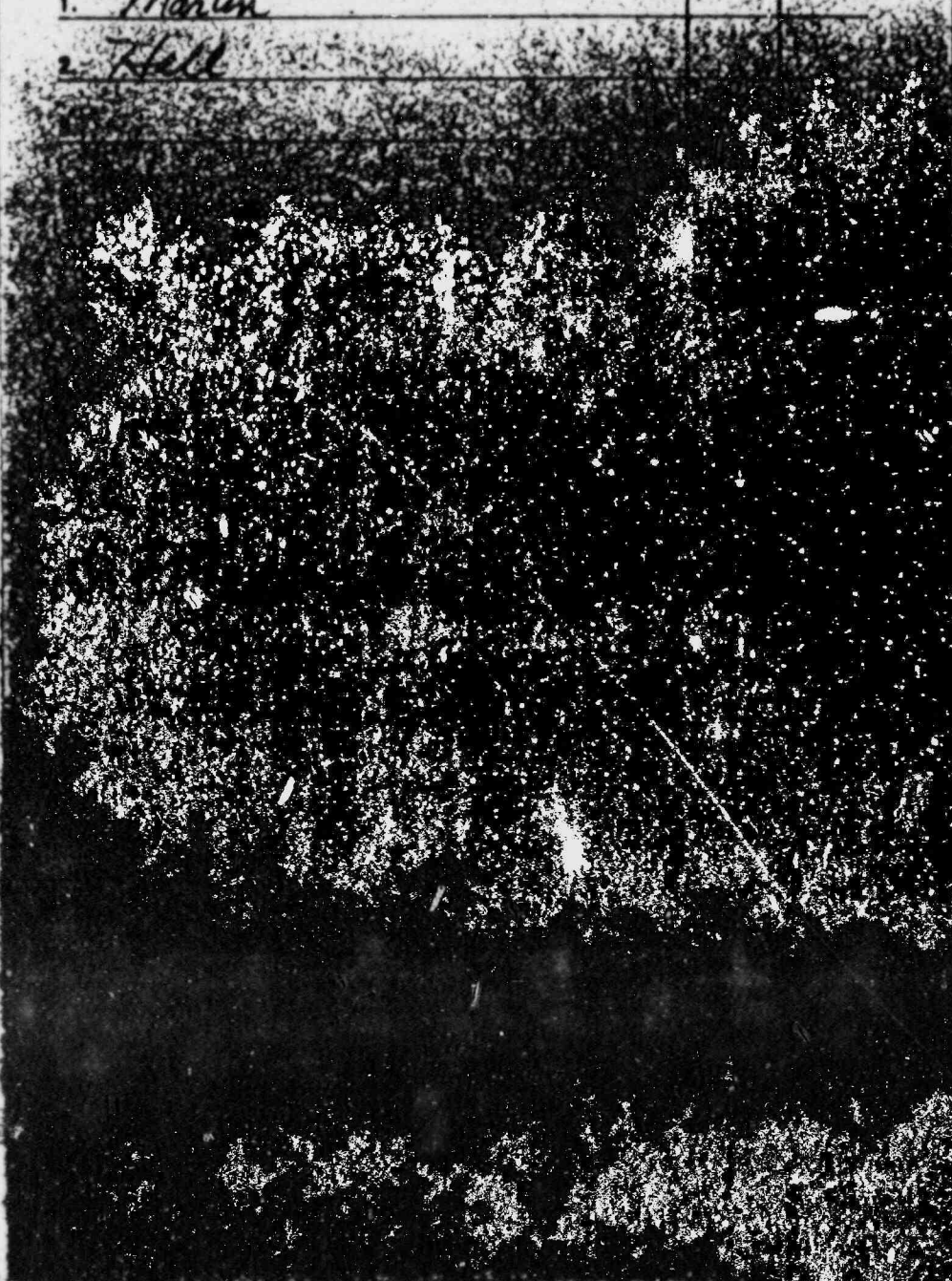
