In response to your survey performed in our Nuclear Medicine Department October 6, 1987, Docket #030-1381, License #29-17623-01, there were two violations reported.

Regarding Item 7, Appendix B, requiring the Radiation Safety Committee to meet at least once in each quarter, I have enclosed copies of the minutes of the four meetings of 1987. The last meeting in November was conducted after the inspection was scheduled.

Regarding Item 17, Section D.2 which requires that the method for performing wipe tests be sufficiently sensitive for comparison against a table of contamination limits set in Section F, we are purchasing a Ludlum 14C GM meter to use in the interim until a Well-counter instrument can be purchased for such tests.

I trust this will satisfy the inspection violations. Please contact me or the Radiology Manager, Joseph Semancik, at this same address if we can be of further assistance.
