On April 27, 1978 the Critical Mass Energy Project filed a Freedom of Information Act request with your agency for a listing of all out-of-town trips and the associated costs for each sitting NRC commissioner. Specifically, CMEP requested "a tabulation of the costs charged to the United States Government for each visit."


Although it was not explicitly stated at the time, CMEP would also like to obtain a listing of the entourage which accompanied each Commissioner on the out-of-town trips. The itemized costs each member of the Commissioner's party charged to the United States Government should be included in the response where possible. Where available, travel vouchers also should be forwarded.

Finally, CMEP would like to further clarify that the period of the request should be current through June 1. If you should encounter any difficulties meeting this request, please contact our office.

Since this request is merely a clarification of the April 27 correspondence initiating FOIA action, we expect the NRC will treat this letter as part of our original filing.
