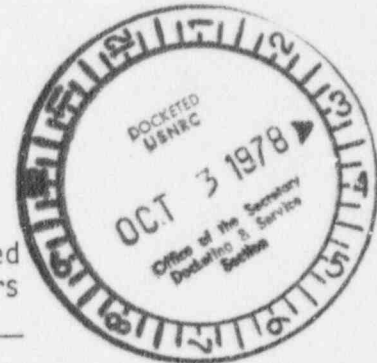

As promised in my letter dated September 25, 1978, and in the Staff testimony at 2-5, enclosed is testimony by Messrs. Ronald Frahm and Brian Sheron on the matter of ECCS water diversion during a loca. This testimony demonstrates new information obtained from the Allens Creek application which changes the peak cladding temperature from 2038°F to 2085°F.
