Dear Sir:

In accordance with the provision of 10CFR50.54(p), please find enclosed revised pages of the Pilgrim Station Security Plan. These changes to the Security Plan reflect the current PNPS management organization.

As discussed in the referenced BECo letter, we have established a number of temporary organizational elements to strengthen planning, control and performance of plant functions. Appropriate organizational elements and resources were incorporated from the temporary organization into the current nuclear organization. The current nuclear organization assumed full responsibility for operation of Pilgrim on February 1, 1988.
