This refers to the inspection conducted by Ms. M. Campbell of this office on October 13, 1978, of activities authorized by NRC License No. 37-16179-01 and to the discussions of our findings held by Ms. Campbell with yourself at the conclusion of the inspection.

The area examined during this inspection was limited to a discussion of your future plans for use of cesium-137 sources in interlock systems. From this discussion, it is our understanding that this interlock system was never purchased and that you do not anticipate the possession of lice and material under the authorization of this license.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.
