In response to your letter of March 23, 1987 and our several telephone calls since that date I am supplying additional information regarding our amendment request to license no. 21-03001-01. First our request to add Dr. Selis to the license is being withdrawn. Dr. Selis has left Hutzel Hospital and I have sent copies of his Preceptor Statement to his new hospital.

Second, and most importantly, is the request for the M & SE bone mineral analyzer. I am requesting that the use of the M & SE bone mineral analyzer (Osteotech) and all approved M & SE sources of Gd-153 be added to the Hutzel Hospital License. As per our telephone call on 7 July 87 this device has just recently been approved by the NRC for human use.

Our previous control number is 82396. Please process this request as soon as possible. The hospital has been waiting to take delivery of the unit and start service since March.


