Your referenced letter transmitted the results of NRC Inspection Report No. 50-361/97-07 and 50-362/97-07, conducted April 7-11, 1997, at the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, Units 2 and 3. The letter, also, requested Edison's confirmation of a regulatory commitment.

During the exit meeting on April 11, 1997, Edison management confirmed that a security officer would be posted, at the North Security Processing Facility entrance turnstiles, during peak traffic flow periods. Further, the requirement to post the security officer would be made a part of the appropriate Security procedure.

On April 24, 1997, the enclosed Security Procedure SO123-IV-5.1, "Protected and Vital Area Access," was modified (Temporary Change Notice 5-5), as stated above.

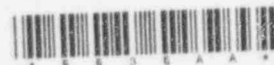
