The Office of the Inspector General (OIG), U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) initiated this inquiry after receiving information which alleged there was a lack of sensitivity on the part of the Region I staff in dealing with allegers and their concerns. As a result of these concerns, OIG examined two specific instances which were reportedly indicative of the Region I staff's lack of sensitivity with respect to its treatment of allegers and the handling of their allegations.
