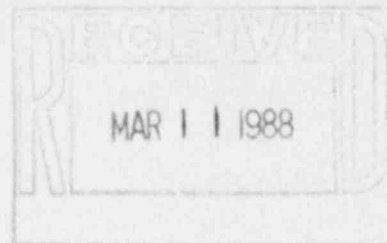

We have reviewed your letter of February 1, 1988 which provided your comments to our initial response to the subject potential violation finding. Your letter indicated that you still believe the findings associated with this potential violation constitute a violation of 10 CFR 73.55 and of commitments contained in the ANO Industrial Security Plan. In order to provide a comprehensive response to the potential violation, AP&L requests an additional 30 days to prepare our submittal. We believe a request is warranted due to the complexity of the issue and the time required to thoroughly research the regulatory requirements in this area. This extension would provide for our response on March 29, 1988.
