This letter confirms the dates April 11 to 15, 1988 for the NRC equipment qualification (EQ) inspection at Beaver Valley Power Station, Unit 2. These dates were established during telephone conversations with Mr. F. Lipchik of your staff. We will discuss the logistics of the inspection in detail with your staff.

A management entrance meeting is scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on April 11, 1988 at the plant site. A management exit meeting is tentatively scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on April 15, 1988, also at the plant site. A plant walkdown inspection of equipment is tentatively planned for April 13, 1988.

The inspection will include the following:

1. Review of your implementation of a 10 CFR 50.49 program including preservation of the qualified status of qualified equipment.
2. Review of your implementation of EQ corrective action commitments (See Safety Evaluation Report and Supplements 1-6).
3. Review of EQ documentation files.
4. Physical inspection of selected equipment.
