SUBJECT: NOTICE OF VIOLATION

(NRC INSPECTION REPORT NOS. 50-259/88-04, 50-260/88-04, AND

50-296/88-04)

This refers to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) inspection conducted by G. L. Paulk on February 1-29, 1988. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Browns Ferry facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed inspection report.

Areas examined during the inspection included operational safety, maintenance observation, surveillance testing observation, quality surveillance report reviews, reportable occurrences, employee concerns, design control, and restart testing. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

The inspection findings indicate certain activities appeared to violate NRC requirements. The violations, references to pertinent requirements, and elements to be included in your response are described in the enclosed Notice of Violation.

An unresolved item identified in paragraph 5 pertains to a problem with security ministrative controls and documentation for out of service equipment. NRC Region II specialists will further evaluate the extent and spinificance of the problem.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and its enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

The responses directed by this letter and the enclosures are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Maragement and Budget issued under the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.
