SUBJECT: PROPOSED LICENSE TO EXPORT HIGH-ENRICHED URANIUM TO
THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY AND THE NETHERLANDS
(APPLICATION XSNM-1104)

This is to advise you that the Commissioners have reviewed the subject license to Transnuclear, Incorporated. The Commission (with three Commissioners (Hendrie, Kennedy, and Ahearne) concurring and Commissioner Gilinsky noting without objection), has accepted your recommendation for export to the Federal Republic of Germany and the Netherlands of 15.976 kilograms of uranium, enriched to 93.30% U-235, in the form of U₃O₈. Commissioner Bradford concurred subject to the completion of the relevant facility attachments.

The Office of International Programs was informed of this action by telephone on October 13, 1978.

It is requested that you provide written notification of the issuance and delivery of this license to Transnuclear to the Office of the Secretary by c.o.b. October 17, 1978.
