Please amend the above License as follows:

1. Remove the name J. Thomas Miller, M.D., as both the Authorized User and the Radiation Safety Officer from the above mentioned license (June 4, 1987).
2. Add the name of Jack P. Smith, M.D., as Radiation Safety Officer. (This is with consultation assistance from John F. Agnew, Ph. D., Radiation at Parkview Memorial Hospital, Ft. Wayne, Indiana, as per our license.)

We also wish to amend our Cobalt Teletherapy license #13-01629-04 to increase the allowable source strength and to add some user physicians to our license. We would like authorization for source strengths as large as 7000 curies (6600 RHM), A ECL model C-146 or C-151 or Neutron Products Incorporated Model NPTT-Series. In order to permit source exchange, we would need authorization to possess two such sources at any one time. The increase in this source strength can be justified by the radiation survey performed by John F. Agnew, Ph. D., dated 9-29-83. The increase in source strength is 50% more than our current authorized limit; however, the survey shows that the source head could tolerate at least 69% more activity and the weakest part of the room shielding, the door, could tolerate an increase of output of 120%.

The physician users we would like to add to our Cobalt license are James O. Gates, M.D., certified by the American Board of Radiology and Therapeutic Radiology 6-1-84, David A. Trenkner, M.D., certified by the American Board of Radiology and Therapeutic Radiology, 6-6-86. We do not wish to delete any physician users on the license (other than #1 of this letter).
