Dear Chairman Hendrie:

Along with many other native Californians I have a concern regarding both the operation and the licensing of nuclear test reactors and the storing of nuclear materials. At this time my concern is specifically over the Vallecitos Operations near Pleasanton and my home in San Lorenzo.

In view of the complexities involving groundwater contamination by the discharge of tritium and the lack of long-range knowledge of seismic safety I am <u>opposed</u> to the Vallecitos Operation, including the General Electric Test Reactor (GETR) and the Nuclear Materials Laboratory (License No. SNM-960) which is licensed to store 150 kilograms of plutonium. I believe that there should be a permanent shutdown of these facilities.

We who live so close to this operation must be allowed to participate in related decisions. Please see that I receive notice of any hearings that are concerned with these matters.
