Gentlemen:

By letter dated September 24, 1986 (Serial No. NLS-85-342), Carolina Power & Light Company provided an update to our Shift Technical Advisor (STA) Program for the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant. The letter indicated that the use of contract engineers to fulfill the STA requirements would be necessary until the specified positions were filled and the individuals properly trained.

The Company has now staffed the STA Program with appropriately trained personnel such that contract engineering personnel are no longer needed. If the Company should determine at a future date that qualified contract engineering personnel are required to support the STA Program, concurrence will again be requested on an "as needed" basis.
