On May 23, 1997, the NRC completed an inspection at your Fermi 2 reactor facility. The enclosed report presents the results of that inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress. The objective of the inspection effort was to determine whether activities authorized by the license were conducted safely and in accordance with NRC requirements. The summary contained in the report provides an overview of our assessment of your security program performance.

No violations of NRC requirements were noted within the areas inspected. Short term goals identified in the Security Excellence Plan (SEP) were being met and adequate progress was being achieved in attaining long term goals. Security staff appeared committed to assuring success of the SEP objectives. Several indicators were noted during this inspection which showed that the concerns identified in Inspection Report 50-341/96015 were being effectively addressed. The security force staffing levels and performance appeared to be stabilizing.
