We are completing design of an addition to our Service Building which will be constructed on the plant north side of the present building. The addition will be a 95' x 215', three-story structure which will provide approximately 61,500 additional square feet of floor space within the Protected Area.

The Protected Area fence, CCTV cameras, and intrusion detection devices have been relocated to allow for the construction of the building. These changes have been submitted to the NRC as Revision 13 to the Callaway Plant Security Plan.

The construction of the new building will begin in April, 1988. This Addendum to the Security Plan is provided to explain the temporary security measures which will be taken during the construction period. These temporary measures have been designed to ensure that the following goals are met:

1. Ensure that the project has minimal effect on physical protection of the Callaway Plant.
2. Maintain security effectiveness equivalent to that provided by the implementation of the Security Plan.

The enclosed document contains Safeguards Information within the scope of 10 CFR 73.21. Removal of enclosures declassifies this document.


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3. Allow construction to occur outside of the Protected Areas as much as possible so as not to interfere with the security program within the Protected Area.
4. Allow construction to be accomplished as expeditiously as possible so that the temporary security measures may be discontinued.

To accomplish these goals, the attached addendum to our Security Plan is provided. Incorporated into this addendum are changes within the scope of 10 CFR 50.54(p) which do not decrease the effectiveness of the program.
