This refers to the inspection activities performed by our resident inspector, Mr. R. G. Taylor, of activities authorized by NRC Construction Permit Nos. CPPR-126 and 127 for the Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station, Units 1 and 2, and to the discussion of the findings by the inspector with members of your staff on October 5, 1978.

During the inspection, it was found that certain activities under your license appear to be in noncompliance with Part 50, Title 10, of the Code of Federal Regulations. The item of noncompliance and references to the pertinent requirements are identified in the enclosed Notice of V tion. Details of this item will be included in an inspection repetition. Details of the near future and identified as Inspection Report 445/78-16; 50-446/78-16.

Section 2.201 requires you to submit to this office, with3 days of your receipt of this notice, a written statement or explaion in reply including: (1) corrective steps which have been taken by ou, and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further noncompliance; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved.
