This letter provides The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company's response to NRC Bulletin 88-01 "Defects In Westinghouse Circuit Breakers."

Westinghouse DS series circuit breakers are not presently used at the Perry Nuclear Power Plant. In order to control future use of DS-206, DSL-206, DS-416, DSL-416 and DS-420 circuit breakers, these breakers have been added to the PNPP Restricted List to prohibit their procurement as presently constructed.
