
SUBJECT: Grand Gulf Nuclear Station Units 1 and 2 Docket Nos. 50-416 and 50-417 License No. NPF-29 Response to Generic Letter 83-28, Items 2.1.2 and 2.2.2 AECM-88/0062

In response to a March 11, 1988 telephone call between System Energy Resources, Incorporated (SERI) and the NRC, this letter provides the NRC requested information to supplement the previously submitted SERI response to Generic Letter 83-28 Items 2.1.2 and 2.2.2 contained in letter AECM-84/0508, dated November 19, 1984. During the March 11, 1988 telephone conversation, the NRC requested SERI to explain how SERI assures that all General Electric (GE) Service Information Letters (SILs) are received.

All GE SILs sent to SERI are addressed to the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station (GGNS) Site Director with a receipt acknowledgement form attached. The form is completed by SERI and returned to GE notifying them of the SIL's receipt.

In addition to the above, GE sends to SERI approximately every six months a listing of all SILs issued to date. SERI uses that listing to verify all SILs have been received. Any SILs identified as not being received are requested from GE.

This letter is the final response for closure of Generic Letter 83-28 Items 2.1.2 and 2.2.2.
