CLASSIFICATION PROGRAM FOR ALL SAFETY RELATED COMPONENTS
(TAC NO. 53700/53701).

RE: PEACH BOTTOM ATOMIC POWER STATION, UNIT NOS. 2 AND 3

The Philadelphia Electric Company (licensee) was required by Generic Letter 83-28, Item 2.2.1 to describe in considerable detail the program for classifying all safety-related components other than RTS components as safety-related on documents and in information handling systems that are used to control plant activities that may affect these components. The licensee has responded and the staff's review of these responses, as documented in the enclosed contractor's report (EG&G-NTA-7283), finds the responses to be acceptable. The enclosed staff safety evaluation documents concurrence with the contractor's findings and also finds the licensee's responses for this item to be acceptable. We, therefore, consider Item 2.2.1 to be closed by this action. TAC No. 53700/53701 remains open since Generic Letter 83-28, item 2.2.2 remains open.
