

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Baltimore Gas and Electric Company
Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Station

Docket Nos. 50-352; 50-318
License Nos. DPR-53; DPR-69

During an NRC inspection conducted on February 11-12, 1988, a violation of NRC requirements was identified. In accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedures for NRC Enforcement Actions", 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C (Enforcement Policy 1987), the violation is set forth below:

Technical Specifications, 6.8.1.e, "Procedures", requires that procedures be established, implemented and maintained for Emergency Plan implementation.

Emergency Procedure ERPIP 3.0, "Immediate Actions", Attachment 2, Page 2, requires, among other things, that whenever an ALERT is declared at the facility, all personnel in the emergency response organization shall be notified and recalled, and the emergency response facilities shall be activated.

Contrary to the above, at 5:46 PM on February 1, 1988, the licensee declared an Alert because of the loss of all Unit 2 control room annunciators for greater than one hour; however, portions of ERPIP 3.0 were not implemented in that certain emergency response personnel were not notified and recalled as appropriate, and the emergency response facilities were not activated.

This is a Severity Level IV Violation (Supplement VIII)

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, Baltimore Gas and Electric Company is hereby required to submit to this office within 30 days of the date of the letter transmitting this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) the reasons for the violations; if admitted; (2) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (3) the corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (4) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending this response time.
