Subject: ORDER CONTINUING SUSPENSION OF LICENSE AND ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE  
WHY LICENSE SHOULD NOT BE REVOKED AND NOTICE OF VIOLATION

By EN 87-82 dated September 21, 1987, the Commission was notified that the staff issued an Order Suspending License (Effective Immediately) for transportation violations. The inspection and investigation revealed additional significant transportation violations. Accordingly, an Order Continuing Suspension of License and Order to Show Cause Why License Should Not be Revoked and Notice of Violation have been issued today.

A SECY paper is being issued concurrently and it forwards a copy of the Order and Notice of Violation.

Under the terms of the Order, the licensee may, within 20 days of the date of receipt of the Order, file a written answer under oath or affirmation and may also request a hearing. However, a written answer or request for a hearing will not stay the immediate effectiveness of this Order.
