> As you know, NECNP has outstanding discovery requests to you concerning the staff's position on the New Hampshire emergency plans. Without rehearsing the full history of this, there is no question but that your obligation to respond continues.

> At the last hearing session, you represented that it would not be possible for you to answer questions or produce documents regarding the bases for the staff's position because the position has not yet been developed or approved by NRC management.
