Subject: Changes to Seabrook Station Radiological Emergency Plan


Gentlemen:

In accordance with the requirements of 10CFR 50.54(q) and 10CFR 50 Appendix E, enclosed are changes to the Seabrook Station Radiological Emergency Plan. These changes do not reduce the effectiveness of the Plan, and the Plan, as changed, continues to meet the standards of 10CFR 50.47(b) and the requirements of 10 CFR 50 Appendix E.

In addition, supplemental information that will revise Appendix E of the Plan will be submitted at a future date. This supplement will describe the methods that will replace the fixed siren portion of the Public Alert and Notification System that is currently being removed from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts portion of the EPZ.
