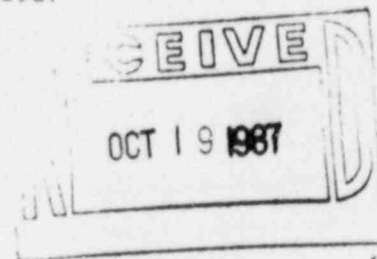

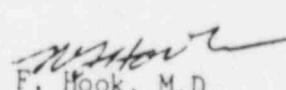

Reference Preceptor Statement on Fred A. Matthews, M.D. (enclosure). Our records indicate Dr. Matthews received a total of 666 hours of formal lecture and case review over a three year period from 1-July-68 to 1-July-71 in various subjects of clinical radioisotope training. These courses included x-ray and laboratory courses and radiation physics and instrumentation, radiation protection, mathematics pertaining to the use and measurement of radioactivity, radiation biology and radiopharmaceutical chemistry in addition to laboratory experience of approximately 150 hours which included radiopharmaceutical preparation, generator and generator kits and Reagent kits as well as use of radiobioassay, nuclear imaging, in-vivo measurements and therapy with sealed and unsealed sources.
