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

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

To clarify responsibility, by means of this agreement, F. C. Lindemann, M.D., a Radiologist on the medical staff of the Memorial Hospital of Sheridan County, is hereby charged and accepts the responsibility to insure that all testing and procedures required under the hospital's Radiation Therapy and Isotope Licenses are accomplished, recorded and record of same are maintained in safe order so as to insure full compliance with licensure requirements now in effect and as may be required in the future.

Said records shall be maintained under an appropriate security system and available at all times to the licensed institution.

Further, a formal report will be given to the Radiation Safety Committee at its quarterly meetings regarding the proper testing, maintenance and recording of all required tests.
