Your letter dated September 23, 1987 indicated that in order to perform some of the required fire brigade training activities, Detroit Edison Company (DECo) utilizes the Toledo Fire Academy facilities. Because these facilities are not owned nor controlled by DECo, a potential exists where DECo employees' training may be rescheduled at the last minute and exceed the time frame required by Appendix A to BTP 9.5-1. Consequently, you proposed changes to the fire brigade training schedules to allow some flexibility in scheduling the use of the Toledo Fire Department facility.

We have reviewed your request and conclude that your proposed changes to permit a maximum allowable extension of the scheduled intervals of 25%, not to exceed 3.25 times the specified interval for any three consecutive intervals, are acceptable.
