As a result of the conference call with the Licensing Board on April 5, 1988, you were to make a decision whether to proffer Dave McLoughlin as a witness to be deposed by intervenors or whether, instead, to withdraw FEMA's Supplemental Testimony dated January 25, 1988. The Intervenor's response to FEMA's testimony depends on whether the January 25th testimony will be proffered. Therefore, in light of the Board's schedule for filing testimony, we need to know immediately if FEMA will be withdrawing its January testimony.
