

As a result of the conference call with the Licensing Board on April 5, 1988, you were to make a decision whether to proffer Dave McLoughlin as a witness to be deposed by intervenors or whether, instead, to withdraw FEMA's Supplemental Testimony dated January 25, 1988. The Intervenors' response to FEMA's testimony depends on whether the January 25th testimony will be proffered.
