

Subject: Reply to Notice of Violation NRC Specific License No. 04-23264-01 Docket No. 030-20431

Gentlemen:

Due to a recent inspection of the Instrumentation Resources Facility located in Minnetonka, Minnesota it was discovered that the storage address listed on the license was incorrect.

- The reason for the violation was due to an oversight during annual program reviews and a lack of communication between the field office and NDC in Irwindale, California.
- A request, dated April 28, 1997, to amend the license with the new address was submitted to the Walnut Creek office.
- 3) NDC has recently reorganized the Radiation Safety Office by assigning a new Radiation Safety Officer who will have more time to oversee the program. More thorough program reviews plus an emphasis on field office communications will help insure that this type of situation does not occur again.
- 4) Compliance will be achieved upon amendment of the license by the NRC.
