SEQUOYAE NUCLEAR PLANT UNIT 2 - STRESS CORROSION CRACKING IN TUBING ON THE REACTOR COOLANT PUMP OIL COOLERS - SQRD-50-328/81-11 - SECOND INTERIM REPORT

The subject deficiency was initially reported to NRC-OIE Inspector R. W. Wright on December 2, 1980, in accordance with 10 CFR 50.55(e) as NCR SQN NEB 8028. An interim report was submitted on January 2, 1981. We expect to submit our next report by March 27, 1981. We consider 10 CFR 21 applicable to this deficiency.

TVA has received and is evaluating the quotation from Westinghouse for replacing the unit 2 reactor coolant pump lubrication oil a coler tubing with 90-10 copper-nickel. TVA is also investigating the idea of plugging the oil cooler tubes which leak. This would be acceptable in view of the fact that hydrazine, which was used as the component cooling system water treatment, has been removed from the system. Ammonia, which resulted from the decomposition of hydrazine, in conjunction with residual and operating stresses, caused the stress corrosion cracking.
