This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. R. Mendez of this office on December 1, 1987 through January 5, 1988, of the Unit 2 Containment Integrated Leak Rate Test (ILRT) at LaSalle County Nuclear Station, Units 1 and 2, authorized by NRC Facility Operating Licenses No. NPF-11 and No. NPF-18 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. G. J. Diederich at the conclusion of the inspection.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.
