Although Item 19 of your application has been amended to reference Regulatory Guide 8.20, Rev. 1, it should be noted that 10 CFR 35.315(a)(8) requires that bioassays be performed for each individual who helped prepare or administer a therapeutic dose of iodine-131. This section of the regulations became effective on April 1, 1987.

Also, please note that 10 CFR 20.207 requires that licensed materials be secured from unauthorized removal. The radioactive waste area labeled 2H201 on Enclosure 13 of your letter dated September 16, 1987, as well as all other areas where licensed materials are used or stored, should be locked when unattended by authorized personnel.

Any future correspondence relating to your license should specifically reference your license and docket numbers to expedite your inquiry.
