Answer. At this time, the County has determined that LILCO's proposal may violate the following State law provisions: Sections 305, 1604, 1709, 1711, 1805, 3623, 3624 and 3635 of the

Education Law; Part 156 of Title 8 of the Official Compilation of Codes, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York; Article 19-A of the Vehicle and Traffic Law; and Part 6 of Title 15 of the Official Compilation of Codes, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York.

Further research, analysis and discovery may reveal additional State and/or local laws, regulations and ordinances that would be violated by LILCO's proposal.
