Please identify all persons having knowledge of the matters set forth in the Licensee's "Answer; Request For Rescission Or Relaxation Of Order; Request for Hearing," dated October 5, 1987 (hereafter, "Answer"), and list for each such person his/her home address, business address, and home and business telephone numbers.

INTERROGATORY 2

Please identify all witnesses you expect to offer at the hearing in this matter and list for each his/her home address, business address, and home and business telephone numbers.

INTERROGATORY 3

Please state each and every matter as to which each witness will testify and state the substance of his/her testimony as to each and every such matter.

INTERROGATORY 4

At page 9 of the Licensee's Answer, the Licensee states that "[a]II shipping papers required by NRC and DOT regulations were provided by Gordon Finlay to Ron Austin..." on the afternoon of August 16, 1987. Did Mr. Finlay provide to Ron Austin Department of the Army forms for the shipment of hazardous wastes to a U.S. Army installation (Johnston Island)? If so, please provide a copy of such forms.

INTERROGATORY 5

At page 10 of the Licensee's Answer, the Licensee states that "[t]he crated and labeled camera and other parcels were accepted by MAC...." on the afternoon of August 16, 1987. Please state the basis for this assertion.

DOCUMENT REQUEST 1

At pages 3-4 of the Licensee's Answer, the Licensee states that Mr. Finlay advised NRC Region V by telephone on August 18, 1987, of the violation of NRC requirements in connection with the transportation of the radioactive source from Oahu to Johnston Island on that date. Please provide any documentation of this call.

DOCUMENT REQUEST 2

Please provide a copy of any documents that the Licensee intends to identify or offer into evidence at the hearing on this matter.
