CONFIRMATORY MEMORANDUM AND ORDER (Governments' Motion for Extension of Discovery on Role Conflict of Bus Driver Issue)

After consideration of the Governments' motion for a 30-day discovery period on the remanded school bus driver issue, and the parties responses during a telephone conference conducted on January 28, 1988, the Board confirms its Order granting an extension of the discovery period until February 19. An extension was warranted, in the Board's judgment, due to the existence of compelling reasons related to late filings and a exceptional heavy work schedule.

At the Staff's request, and with no party objecting, the Board has granted a one-day extension to the parties to respond to LILCO's Summary

Disposition on Contentions 1, 2 and 9-- Immateriality. Non-availability of essential employees is the reason for the extension.
