Dear Mr. Grossman:

This letter is to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated October 31, 1978 on behalf of Georgians Against Nuclear Energy.

You requested that the Commission suspend the construction permits of Georgia Power Company for the Alvin W. Vogtle Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2, and hold hearings to consider the need for the Vogtle units in light of allegedly new evidence concerning growth in electrical demand in Georgia and relative costs of energy alternatives.

Your request is being treated under 10 CFR 2.206 of the Commission's regulations, and is currently under consideration. We will inform you of our decision within a reasonable time. I enclose for your information a copy of the notice that is being filed with the Office of the Federal Register for publication.

In addition, we note that the enclosure to your letter consisted of two pages. If additional pages should have been included, would you be so kind as to forward them.
