Reference 1) Letter from M. R. Wisenburg to Document Control Desk, dated January 18, 1988 (ST-HL-AE-2483)

By Reference 1, HL&P submitted a report on the hydraulic transients that occurred in the South Texas Project Unit 1 main feedwater system while filling the steam generators on January 11, 1988. The hydraulic transients resulted from feeding the steam generators with main feedwater at a temperature above the steam generator secondary side saturation temperature. No damage to plant equipment was discovered after the event. Procedure changes have been made that will preclude recurrence of this type of main feedwater hydraulic transient event.

HL&P committed to perform confirmatory tests to verify that these procedural changes will prevent the observed hydraulic transients. These tests have been successfully completed and are documented in the attached supplemental report. Also provided in the report are discussions on the analysis performed to validate the root cause of the hydraulic events, an evaluation of the impact of the procedural changes on plant operations, and a comparison of the possibility of a similar event occurring at other plants.
